 Innovation Valley by empowering regional ecosystems to co-develop, scale, and
 commercialise deep-tech health solutions through smart specialisation, mentoring, and
 investment readiness.
- VELES Smart Health Excellence Hub
 The project under the HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ACCESS-04 aims to boost innovation excellence in Southeast Europe by building a sustainable, place-based ecosystem powered by a Regional Smart Health Data Space. With a strong focus on widening countries (Bulgaria, Greece, Romania, Cyprus) and support from Sweden, Spain, and Germany, the project advances digital health innovation and regional leadership in healthcare transformation.
- ENACT Advancing Biotech for Better Health

Funded under Horizon Europe, ENACT brings together a pan-European consortium to develop innovative biotech solutions that enhance healthcare delivery and outcomes. With a strong focus on stakeholder collaboration and data-driven insights, the project aims to translate cutting-edge research into real-world health impact across diverse European regions.

• InnoMedCatalyst – Accelerating 5P Digital Health Innovation InnoMedCatalyst is an EU-funded initiative under the I3 Programme, uniting 13 partners from Romania, Poland, Bulgaria, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Greece, and Portugal. The project aims to enhance regional innovation capacity in 5P medicine—predictive, Preventive, Personalised, Participative, and precise—by supporting 36 startups and entrepreneurs through acceleration programs, mentorship, and open innovation platforms.
